FOC QP Set for Saturday, 13 September, 2014 by KZ5D

The date for the next FOC QSO Party is quickly approaching. Now is a good time to put this on your calendar. Block out some time to join in the fun. Our last event in September had a very high number of members and non-members participate. Please spread the word around to all your ham friends so they can join in. This QSO Party gives the FOC members the opportunity to work each other and non-members. Let's see if we can get every FOC member on the air during this 24 hour period. Even if you have just 1 hour to operate, do get on and make some QSOs. Here are the rules:

The Event: Open to all stations worldwide. FOC members contact members and non-members. Other stations contact FOC members only. Call CQBW to solicit contacts.

Duration: 24 hours. 0000Z to 2359Z on Saturday, 13 September, 2014.

Object: FOC members – Contact as many members and non-members on all amateur bands, excluding WARC bands.

Non-Members – Contact as many FOC members as possible on all amateur bands including VHF. However, the WARC bands are excluded.

Exchange: For FOC members: RST, Name, & FOC Number. Non-members: RST & Name

Frequencies: CW portions of all appropriate bands, from 015 to 040. Top Band: Avoid the DX Window

Activity Report: FOC members – Report total QSOs and total FOC QSOs, counted once per band.. For example: 302/177 where the first number would be total QSOs, followed by the total FOC member QSOs. **Non-Members** – Report total QSOs with FOC members, counted once per band.

No logs as we are only using the honor system. Handsome certificates presented to top scoring members and non-members on each continent. Send your report to: KZ5D@aol.com no later than 7 days after the contest.
