Committee News by G3RWF

The Committee met by Skype on 19th May, with a full agenda. Our next meeting is on 23rd June.

Appointments: We are delighted to announce that Nigel, G3TXF – long-standing member and DX super-star has agreed to be our President for 2016. He will succeed Don, G3XTT after the AGM. Colin, G3VTT is standing down then after a very successful period as our Activity Coordinator. Iain MØPCB will be taking over – many thanks, Colin and Iain.

Subscriptions and Membership: We are planning to simplify arrangements for subscription payment, in line with many other clubs. We also talked about club size and what is consistent with the club's objectives and ethos. Club membership is hovering around the size indicated in our Constitution (500). We felt the club should remain small enough for members to know each other well but we are asking for member views. After that positive discussion, Committee was dismayed to have to consider yet again a substantial number of objections to a nomination, which they upheld.

IT and Publications: Wild Apricot- the IT system we use for the Club website - has announced a very large fee increase. The Committee is considering payment options and has until July to make a final decision.

Maintaining the Ethos of FOC by the Committee

Our constitution limits membership to approximately 500 members, subject to the determination of the committee. Currently our active membership is around 500 and we have a long nominations list.

In some ways this is a healthy situation but it has led the Committee to consider some basic issues about the club's fundamental ethos. We have also questioned whether the burgeoning level of nominations is in danger of making the club too large to maintain that ethos. One additional concern is the surprising speed with which some nominations receive additional support – which might suggest an element of soliciting. This is possible as our member list is an open document. Our rules are not about exclusivity – they are there to try to ensure, in the words of our constitution, "(not only) the highest quality of CW operating but also a happy, peaceful cohesion".

If you want a club with no specific responsibilities, there are plenty around which will give you a certificate for the shack wall! FOC is a club in which those accepting membership also agree to accept responsibilities (see page 8 of the Call Book). The Committee has spent much time seeking to ensure that members are active on the air. We feel we now need to act to protect the club's ethos. To help do that we propose:

- To invite all members to comment on these points (to the Committee via G3RWF);
- To maintain our current approximate size and, after the AGM, re-introduce the QRX list (the waiting list for those who have achieved successful nominations but await a vacancy). The QRX list would not apply to Associate Members returning to full membership.
- Ensure increased vigilance of the nominations list for signs of soliciting rather than on-air performance as the means of obtaining nominations. Our club depends greatly on the honour and goodwill of its members and we ask for support in taking this action.
